## Artifort unveils a new collection where design heritage and innovation come together during Milan Design Week 2026

During Milan Design Week 2026, Artifort unveils **four new designs** that explore the boundaries of contemporary design. Artifort invites press, architects and partners to discover the new collection and be inspired by a unique combination of design heritage and forward-thinking design during **Salone del Mobile 2026 in Milan – Hall 22, Stand B39**.

- **New: Beso Circulo by Khodi Feiz**  
Introducing Beso Circulo, a new family of moulded shell seating crafted from **100% recycled polypropylene with fiber glass**, continuing the characteristic lines and comfort of the beloved Beso collection.
- **New: Moulin bar stool by Pierre Paulin**  
Originally conceived in the late 1950s, the **Moulin family** reflects Paulin's early explorations of elegant, minimalist seating forms, now translated into **a refined higher version** that remains true to its timeless design language.
- **Reintroduction: F518 & F522 by Geoffrey D. Harcourt RDI**  
Alongside the new introductions, Artifort revisits two iconic designs by Geoffrey D. Harcourt: the F518 and F522, **reissued** with careful attention to their **original character** and craftsmanship.

In addition to the 2026 collection, Artifort presents **an exclusive homage to Kho Liang Ie** in central Milan at Masterly – The Dutch in Milano, paying tribute to the legendary designer and former Artifort art director of the 1960s. The special installation highlights timeless design through reuse and reupholstery, showcasing **a vibrant dialogue between design history and modern, sustainable interpretation**.

With its 2026 novelties, Artifort underlines its expertise in creating distinctive, timeless and comfortable high-quality furniture, while both the launch and the installation emphasise its ongoing pursuit of innovation, craftsmanship and enduring design.

## **Beso Circulo**

Khodi Feiz - Design 2026

Introducing Beso Circulo, a new family of moulded shell seating crafted from 100% recycled polypropylene with fiber glass, continuing the characteristic lines and comfort of the beloved Beso collection. Compact, lightweight and simple in form, the design features a subtle cut-out that imparts a distinctive, refined detail. The shell is offered in a vibrant palette of eight colours, combining a contemporary expression with responsible material use.

Crafted from high-quality recycled materials and fully demountable, Beso Circulo combines durability, effortless maintenance and inherent versatility. With a range of base options, a wide selection of fabrics, and the option of a seat cushion integrated into the design, the Beso Circulo series adapts seamlessly to diverse interiors. It combines refined versatility with timeless elegance, reflecting the distinctive quality for which the Beso collection is renowned.

## F518 - F522

Geoffrey D. Harcourt RDI - Design 1979 and 1984, reintroduction 2026

The F518 lounge chair, designed by Geoffrey D. Harcourt, is a defining example of refined mid-century modern design and a hallmark of Artifort's iconic F500 series. The series originated from Harcourt's vision of informal, intuitive lounging, with every element carefully tailored to the human body. Originally designed in 1979 and reissued in 2026 alongside the related F522, the F518 translates this philosophy into a bold, sculptural silhouette, featuring a deep, enveloping seat and an ergonomically shaped high-back shell. Constructed around a moulded beechwood frame with high-resilience foam, it offers a supportive yet relaxed seating experience designed for prolonged lounging. The distinctive disc base with swivel function enhances both the visual lightness and the practical functionality of the design.

Within the same family, the F522 lounge chair presents a related interpretation, distinguished by its removable upholstered seat pad and subtle, refined detailing that transform the lounge chair's tactile and visual character. Both models share the same generous comfort and recognizable design language of the F500 series, while each offers its own unique presence. Together, they exemplify Harcourt's enduring design ethos: an iconic lounge collection that seamlessly unites sculptural form, ergonomic precision, and versatile adaptability across diverse interior settings.

### Moulin bar stool

Pierre Paulin - Design 2026

Designed in the late 1950s, the Moulin chair family reflects Pierre Paulin's early explorations of elegant, minimalist seating forms. The addition of a Moulin bar stool builds on this tradition: its slender metal frame and carefully proportioned upholstered seat offer understated elegance and comfort in a higher version.

A classic, versatile piece in which simplicity, comfort, and timeless elegance come together. With a wide choice of high-quality fabrics and leather, the Moulin bar stool is well suited to higher tables, kitchen islands, and a variety of hospitality settings. Since its introduction in 1958, the Moulin chair has evolved into a beloved icon of modern chair design. In addition to the bar stool, the Moulin collection also includes the classic chair (F0927) and the lounge armchair (CM 190), each reflecting the characteristic elegance and lightness of Pierre Paulin's early work. Thanks to their timeless silhouettes and balanced proportions, these models are appreciated in both residential and contract interiors, where they continue to inspire generations of design enthusiasts and affirm the Moulin family's international status as a design classic.
